## ECSC Racing Series – Wednesday and Sunday Honors Notice of Race 2020



- 1. **Rules:** The Racing Series will be governed by the Rules as defined in the *Racing Rules of Sailing*. Racing rules will be changed as follow:
  - a. Omit RRS 26, 27, 29, 30, 32, 33, 34, 36. RRS 61.3 Protest Time Limit is modified to include following Protest Forms shall be delivered by email to Score Keeper (Rich Fox, ecsc\_scores@yahoo.com) by email by 7:00 PM the day following the race. A Protest Committee will be assembled.
- 2. Eligibility: The Racing Series is open to boats that have an Active Member, Lake Associate, or Race Fellow of the Eagle Creek Sailing Club aboard as the "Person in Charge". Eligible boats must have an assigned PHRF rating on file and may request a PHRF rating by submitting a PHRF Rating Request Form to the Scorer Keeper (ecsc\_scores@yahoo.com, on or before the first series race for that boat. The PHRF Rating Request Form is available on the Club's website (racing page) at http://www.ecsail.org.
- 3. Fleets: Fleet designation is determined by a boat's assigned PHRF rating (see PHRF Ratings posted on the website). The ECSC racing fleets are:
  - > Blue
  - ➤ Green-1 (mono-hull)
  - ➤ Green-2 (multi-hull)
  - > Red fleet
  - > White
- 4. Fees: None.
- 5. Schedule: All times local:

Wednesday Honors Series – one race scheduled per day. One race constitutes a series.

- a. Wednesdays, July 1 thru August 26, start at 6:50 PM.
- b. Wednesdays, September 2 thru October 14, start at 6:40 PM.

Sunday Honors Series – one race scheduled per day. One race constitutes a series.

- a. Sundays, July 5 thru, October 11. Start at 3:00 PM.
- **6.** Sailing Instructions: Available on the Club's website (racing pages) at http://www.ecsail.org.
- 7. **Venue:** All races shall be on Eagle Creek Reservoir.
- **8. Courses:** Courses shall be provided in the Sailing Instructions.
- 9. Scoring: Scoring shall be by the Low Point Scoring System of Appendix A2.1 of RRS except as modified below.
  - a. Boats must compete in at least 33% of completed races within their fleet to qualify for any series.
  - **b.** 51% of all races (rounded up to the nearest whole number) shall be scored for any one participant.
- 10. Prizes: Series Awards will be given as follows:
  - a. Individual fleets with fewer than four qualified boats first place.
  - b. Individual fleets with four qualified boats first and second place.
  - c. Individual fleets with more than four qualified boats first, second, and third place.
- 11. Insurance: Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance.
- **12. Disclaimer of Liability**: Competitors participate in the series at their own risk See *RRS 4*, *Decision to Race*. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury, or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the sailing series.
