

2020 ECSC Racing Series – Wednesday & Sunday Honors
Sailing Instructions
(Section 7 amended 9/17/20)



1. **Rules:** The Racing Series will be governed by the Rules as defined in the *Racing Rules of Sailing*.
2. **Notices to Competitors:** Notices to competitors will be posted on the bulletin board outside the Race Committee (RC) Headquarters and communicated by email and the club's Facebook page.
3. **Changes to the Sailing Instructions:** Any changes to the *Sailing Instructions* will be communicated by email and the Club's Facebook at least 48 hours prior to the start of the next race.
4. **Schedule of Races**
 - Wednesday Honors Series** – one race scheduled per day. One race constitutes a series.
 - a. Wednesdays, July 1 thru August 26, Start at 6:50 PM.
 - b. Wednesdays, September 2 thru October 14, start at 6:40 PM.
 - Sunday Honors Series** – one race scheduled each day. One race constitutes a series
 - a. Sundays, July 5, October 11. Start at 3:00 PM.
5. **Class Flags:**
 - a. RRS #26 and 27 is modified – there will be no visual or sound signals.
6. **Racing Area:** The racing area will be Eagle Creek Reservoir.
7. **Courses: Wednesday.** Will use permanent race marks 1, 5, 6, X and 2.
 - a. **Red Fleet, Green-1, and Green-2 Fleet** – boats must pass within six feet of marks 5, X and 2 in any order.
 - b. **Blue Fleet and White Fleet** – boats must pass within six feet of marks 5 and X in any order.
8. **Course: Sunday.** All Fleets will use permanent marks 1, 3, 4, 6 with marks 3 and 4 to be used as a gate.
9. **The Start: Wednesday Honors Series**
 - a. Starting line will be between permanent marks 1 and 6.
 - b. Boats shall start at 6:50 PM (July 1 thru August 26).
 - c. Boats shall start at 6:40 PM (September 2 thru October 14).
 - d. RRS #26 and 27 is modified – there will be no visual or sound signals.
10. **The Start: Sunday Honors Series**
 - a. Starting line will be between permanent marks 1 and 6.
 - b. Boats shall start at 3:00 PM.
 - c. RRS #26 and 27 is modified – there will be no visual or sound signals.
11. **The Finish: Wednesday Honors Series and Sunday Honors Series**
 - a. Finish line will be between permanent marks 1 and 6 from the last mark rounded.
 - b. Each boat is required to record their actual finish time (time of day).
 - c. Each boat shall forward their sail number and actual finish time to the Score Keeper by email to ecsc_scores@yahoo.com within 36 hours of finishing. The Score Keeper will send an acknowledgement.
12. **Time Limits: Wednesday Honors Series**
 - a. If no boat in a fleet has passed a course mark by 7:30 PM, the race shall be abandoned for that fleet.
 - b. If no boat in a fleet has finished by 8:30 PM, the race shall be abandoned for that fleet.
13. **Time Limits: Sunday Honors Series**
 - a. If no boat in a fleet has rounded mark #3 or #4 by 4:30 PM, the race shall be abandoned for that fleet.
 - b. If no boat in a fleet has finished by 6:00 PM, the race shall be abandoned for that fleet.
14. **Protests: Wednesday Honors Series and Sunday Honors Series**
 - a. RRS 61.3 Protest Time Limit is modified to include following – Protest Forms shall be delivered by email to Score Keeper (Rich Fox, ecsc_scores@yahoo.com) by email by 7:00 PM the day following the race. A Protest Committee will be assembled.
15. **Scoring:** Scoring shall be by the Low Point Scoring System - Appendix A except as modified below.
 - a. Boats must compete in at least 33% of scheduled races to qualify for any series.
 - b. 51% of all races (rounded up to the nearest whole number) shall be scored for any one participant.
 - c. Boats shall identify the need for a scoring correction to the Score Keeper (ecsc_scores@yahoo.com) within 36 hours after the Score Keeper has distributed the scores by email.
16. **Prizes:** Prizes will be awarded as described in the Notice of Race.
