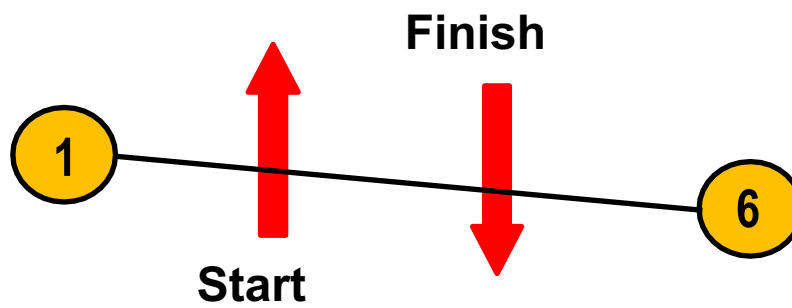
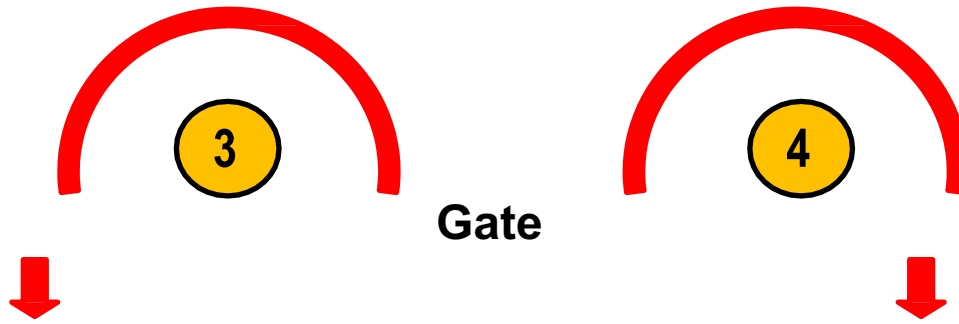


2021 Series Racing Sailing Instructions



1. **Rules:** The Racing Series will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing.
2. **Notices to Competitors:** Notices to competitors will be posted on the bulletin board outside the Race Committee Headquarters.
3. **Changes to the Sailing Instructions:** Any changes to the sailing instructions will be posted 1.0 hour before the first start on the day that it takes effect, except that any changes to the schedule will be posted one week in advance.
4. **Schedule of Races** (See Club website for exact dates. All times Eastern Daylight Time.)
Sunday Honor Series – One race scheduled each day. One race constitutes a series.
 - a) Spring Series – 12 Sundays from 25 April – 18 July. Race starts at 3:00 PM.
 - b) Summer Series – 12 Sundays from 25 July - 10 October. Race starts at 3:00 PM.
5. **Class Flags:**
 - a) RRS #26 and 27 is modified – there will be no visual or sound signals
6. **Racing Area:** The racing area will be Eagle Creek Reservoir.
7. **Courses:** Course for Sunday Honor Series: will use permanent marks 1, 3, 4, 6 with marks 3 and 4 to be used as a gate. This race layout is depicted in the attachments.
8. **The Start: Sunday Honor Series**
 - a) Starting line will be between permanent marks 1 and 6.
 - b) The start time will be at 3:00 PM Eastern Daylight Savings Time.
 - c) It is suggested that racers use a cell phone-based time indicator or download a smartphone APP (such as DigitalClock@) with seconds that will facilitate a coordinated start and finish time for all racers instead of relying on a wrist watch that may not be synchronized with other racers.
9. **The Finish: Sunday Honor Series**
 - a) Finish line will be between permanent marks 1 and 6 from the last mark rounded.
 - b) Each boat is required to record their actual finish time (time of day).
 - c) Each boat shall forward their sail number and actual finish time to the Score Keeper by email to ecsc_scores@yahoo.com within 36 hours of finishing. The Score Keeper will send and acknowledgement.
10. **Time limits: Sunday Honors Series**
 - a) If no boat in a fleet has rounded mark #3 or #4 by 4:30 PM, the race shall be abandon for that fleet.
 - b) If no boat in a fleet has finished by 6:00 PM, the race shall be abandon.
11. **Protests: Sunday Honor Series**
 - a) Protest forms are available at the RC Headquarters. Protests and requests for redress or reopening shall be delivered by email to the ECSC Race Chair by 10 PM the night of the race.
 - b) The Race Chair will post and make an email announcement within 24 hours after that email time to inform competitors of hearings in which they are parties or named as witnesses and where the hearings will be held.
12. **Withdrawal:** boats who retire before finishing do not need to notify anyone of their withdrawal.
13. **Scoring:** Scoring shall be by the Low Point Scoring System - Appendix A except as modified below.
 - a) Boats must compete in at least 33% of scheduled races to qualify for any series.
 - b) 51% of all races (rounded up to the nearest whole number) shall be scored for any one participant.
 - c) Boats shall identify the need for a scoring correction to the Score Keeper (ecsc_scores@yahoo.com) within 36 hours after the Score Keeper has distributed the score by email.
14. **Prizes:** Prizes will be awarded as described in the Notice of Race.
