1. **Rules:** The Regatta will be governed by the Rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (current version).
 - a. **RRS 29.2 General Recall** is modified to allow the race committee to use any amount of time it wishes after the lowering of the general recall flag before resuming racing operations.
2. **Eligibility:** The Racing Series is open to boats that have an Active Member, Lake Associate or Race Fellow of the Eagle Creek Sailing Club aboard as the “Person in Charge” as stated in RRS 46 and ECSC Club bylaws VI C.
3. **Registration:** There is no pre-registration but it would be appreciated if participants send an email to jckohnep@comcast.net or nancygoff.g@gmail.com to indicate one’s intention to race and the number of crew expected. To be eligible to race, Competitors must email us above or present themselves to the race committee table at the waterside shelter no later than 11:30 A.M. on November 13th, 2021. Competitors must have a current PHRF form on file with the ECSC Race Director. ECSC PHRF forms are available at <http://www.ecsail.org/racing.htm>.
4. **Fleets:** This is “sprint” race. All races will be single or double leg races. The attempt will be made to have an upwind, downwind and broad reach race. There is only one PHRF fleet. All starts will be single fleet starts. There will not be individual fleet scoring.
