



2022 ECSC Governor's Cup
Regatta and Lobster Fest
Notice of Race
September 24-25, 2022

1. **Rules:** The Regatta will be governed by the Rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing and changed as follows:
 - a. **RRS 29.2 General Recall** is modified to allow the race committee to use any amount of time it wishes after the lowering of the general recall flag before resuming racing operations.
2. **Eligibility:** The regatta is open to any sailboat legal to sail on Eagle Creek Reservoir (26 feet in length or less).
3. **Entry:** To be eligible to race, competitors must register and pay the appropriate fees by September 18th. Fees are to be paid by check through the mail by **September 18th, 2022**. Boats racing PHRF must have an **ECSC PHRF Handicap Form** on file with ECSC Racing. (Available at registration and online at <http://www.ecsail.org/racing-2022/>) **Fleets requesting a separate start must have at least five boats pre-registered.**

4. **Fleets for racing (subject to pre-registration):**
 - a) J24, b) J22, c) PHRF Fleets d) Other preregistered fleets

Individual starts for one design classes with 5 **pre-registered** boats. Fleets of less than 5 boats may be combined at the discretion of the Race Director. To qualify as **pre-registered**, a **Registration Form** must be received by **September 18, 2022 (See below)**.

b) Fees:

Registration fee is \$20.

A full meal packages may be purchased for \$30 per person via mailed in check with **Registration Form**.

Meal package includes: Continental Breakfast on Saturday and Sunday
Lobster or Steak Dinner on Saturday evening
Lunch Sunday after racing.

Attention: Meal package purchase made on Registration Form must be received by September 18, 2022

Shirts are available for \$15. (See Registration Form)

c) Registration and Payment:

A registration must be filed to participate in this regatta. The **Governor's Cup Registration Form** is available at <http://www.ecsail.org/racing-2022> . Through this form, registration fees, meals and shirts can be purchased and information about your boat and crew can be obtained.

Meals, shirts, dinners and regatta registration fees must be paid with a check to ECSC Racing sent to **John Kohne, 5034 Watersite Circle, Indianapolis, Indiana, 46254**. Checks must be received by September 18th. Your Governor's Cup Registration Form can be sent to racing@ecsail.org or mailed to John Kohne by the September 18th deadline at the above address. **If you are to expect meals** for this event it requires **registration** by **September 18st**.

- i) **Awards:** Governor's Cup Award (Trophy stays on site w/name inscribed) will be awarded to the boat with the lowest total score in **the largest fleet**. In the event of a tie for largest fleet, the fleet with the most out of town boats shall be awarded the Governor's Cup. If there is still a tie, then a coin toss will decide which fleet is awarded the Governor's Cup. In the event of a tie within the fleet, RRS Appendix A8.1 will be applied.
 - a. Fleets with 5 or more boats will receive First, Second and Third Place awards.
 - b. Fleets with 3-4 boats will receive First and Second place awards.
 - c. Fleets with 2 boats will receive a First place award.
- j) **Disclaimer of Liability:** Competitors participate in the series at their own risk See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
