



# 2022 Hornback Regatta Notice of Race October 8, 2022

---

1. **Rules:** The Regatta will be governed by the Rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (current version).
  - a. **RRS 29.2 General Recall** is modified to allow the race committee to use any amount of time it wishes after the lowering of the general recall flag before resuming racing operations.
2. **Eligibility:** The regatta is open to any ECSC member.
3. **Entry:** To be eligible to race, competitors must register by **email** with John Kohne([racing@ecsail.org](mailto:racing@ecsail.org)) or Nancy Goff([nancygoff.g@gmail.com](mailto:nancygoff.g@gmail.com)) by sending them your name, boat model, sail number and boat name or in person at the registration table by 10:00 a.m. October 8, 2022. Boats racing in PHRF handicap fleet must have an ECSC PHRF Handicap Form on file with ECSC Racing.
4. **Fleets:** This is “pursuit” race. There will be a multi-hull fleet and a mono-hull fleet but they will race together and have the same start and starting procedure. All starts will be based upon your boat’s ECSC PHRF rating. There will not be individual fleet scoring within these two designated fleets.
5. **Fees:** There will be no fee for participation in this regatta.
6. **Schedule:** All times Eastern Daylight Saving Time

7. **Sailing Instructions:** Will be available 9:00 AM Saturday, October 8 at the ECSC Registration Table or on-line <http://ecsail.org/racing-2022> .
8. **Venue:** Eagle Creek Sailing Club – 8901 West 46<sup>th</sup> Street, Indianapolis, IN , 46234 .
9. **Courses and Start Times:** Courses and Start Times shall be provided in the Sailing Instructions and determined according to your boat’s PHRF number.
10. **Scoring:** See SI
11. **Awards:**
  - a. Awards will be given for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>, and 4<sup>th</sup> place overall for the mono-hull fleet.
  - b. Awards for the multi-hull fleet will be as follows:
    - i. For a fleet with 4 or more boats there will be First, Second and Third Place awards.
    - ii. For a fleet with 3 boats there will be First and Second place awards.
    - iii. For a fleet with 2 boats there will be only a First place award.
  - c. The winner of a fleet with more than 5 boats will appear on the permanent Hornback Trophy.
