



- Rules: The Regatta will be governed by the Rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing and changed as follows:

 RRS 29.2 <u>General Recall</u> is modified to allow the race committee to use any amount of time it wishes after the lowering of the general recall flag before resuming racing operations.
- 2. Eligibility: The regatta is open to any sailboat of 26 feet in length or less.
- 3. Entry: To be eligible to race, competitors must register and pay the appropriate fees <u>by mail</u> either on or before Wednesday May 31, 2023 or <u>in person</u> at the registration table by 10:00 AM on June 2rd, 2023. Registration forms are available on the ECSC website at <u>www.ecsail.org</u> on the "Racing" page. These can be mailed along with a check to <u>ECSC Mayor's Cup, 5034 Watersite Circle, Indianapolis, IN 46254</u> if one wishes to pre-register for a particular separate start fleet or to simply register for an established fleet. Alternatively, one can bring a check and fill out a form at the registration table on June 3rd by 10:00 AM but this will <u>not count</u> as pre-registration. Boats racing in PHRF handicap fleet must have an ECSC PHRF Handicap Form on file with ECSC Racing. (Available at registration and online at <u>www.ecsail.org</u> on the "Racing" page. <u>Fleets requesting a separate start must have at least five boats pre-registered.</u>
- 4. Fleets (Possible Fleets subject to pre-registration):

 Established Fleets
 J24, J22, Blue-White PHRF Fleet

 Possible Fleets
 Highlander, Flying Scot, S2 7.9, Multihull(Green-2) PHRF, Green-1 PHRF, Red PHRF

There will be individual starts for one design classes with 5 boats <u>pre-registered</u>. Starts for fleets of less than 5 boats may be combined at the discretion of the Race Director.

5. Fees: Registration fee is \$40 (Includes 1 shirt and 1 meal pkg.). Full meal packages may be purchased for \$25 per person through the registration form or at the registration table. The meal package includes: Continental Breakfast on Saturday and Sunday; plus, dinner on Saturday and lunch Sunday after racing. T-shirts are available for \$15 on a first come first serve basis by mail via the registration form at <u>www.ecsail.org</u> on the "Racing" page. One has the option of buying a customized shirt through the online store <u>www.ecscracing.spiritsale.com</u> which closes May 19th. A limited number of Mayor's Cup shirts will be available at registration.

- 8. Venue: Eagle Creek Sailing Club 8901 West 46th Street, Indianapolis, IN
- 9. Courses: Courses shall be provided in the Sailing Instructions
- 10. Scoring: See SI
- 11. Awards: Mayor's Cup Trophy (Stays on site w/name inscribed) will be awarded to the boat with the lowest total score in the largest fleet. In the event of a tie for largest fleet, the fleet with the most out of town boats shall be awarded the Mayor's Cup. If there is still a tie, then a coin flip will decide which fleet is awarded the Mayor's Cup. In the event of a tie within the fleet, RRS Appendix A8.1 will be applied.
 - a. Fleets with 4 or more pre-registered boats will receive First, Second and Third Place trophies and awards.
 - b. Fleets with 3 pre-registered boats will receive First and Second place awards but no trophies.
 - c. Fleets with 2 pre-registered boats will receive First place award and no trophies.
