

## 2023 ECSC Regatta Notice of Race

July 15, 2023



- 1. Rules: The Regatta will be governed by the Rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing and changed as follows:
  - a. **RRS 29.2** <u>General Recall</u> is modified to allow the race committee to use any amount of time it wishes after the lowering of the general recall flag before resuming racing operations.
- 2. **Eligibility:** The regatta is open to any owner of a sailboat of 26 feet in length or less that is a member of the Eagle Creek Sailing Club.
- 3. Entry: To be eligible to race, competitors must register by email either on or before Wednesday July 12, 2022 or in person at the registration table by 10:30 AM on July 15, 2023. Registration can be accomplished by sending an email to racing@ecsail.org and giving your name, boat model and sail number. Alternatively, one can fill out a form at the registration table on July 15<sup>th</sup> by 10:30 AM but this will not count as pre-registration. Boats racing in PHRF handicap fleet must have an ECSC PHRF Handicap Form on file with ECSC Racing. (Available at registration and online at www.ecsail.org on the "Racing" page. Fleets requesting a separate start must have at least five boats pre-registered.
- 4. Fleets (Possible Fleets subject to pre-registration):

Established Fleets J24, J22, Blue-White PHRF Fleet

Possible Fleets Examples Highlander, Flying Scot, S2 7.9, Multihull(Green-2) PHRF, Green-1 PHRF, Red PHRF

This regatta will prioritize <u>one design</u> or <u>PHRF Class racing with PHRF values close to each other</u>. Assigned fleets may be started together but will be scored separately. Fleets may be small as a result of attempts to construct these types of fleets in a trade off to encourage close competition between boats.

Individual fleet starts will be given to <u>one design</u> classes with 5 <u>pre-registered</u> boats.

Starts for fleets of less than 5 boats may be combined at the discretion of the Race Director.

Boats that don't meet above criterion will be assigned into PHRF fleets that best encourage good competitive racing.

- 5. **Fees:** Registration is free as part of the ESCS Beach Party celebration however you do not have to register for the Beach Party to participate in this regatta. You must register for the Beach Party through the Social Committee structure not through racing. Soft drinks will be available but there will be no food provided except as part of the Beach Party event.
- 6. Schedule: All times Eastern Daylight Saving Time

- 9. **Courses:** Courses shall be provided in the Sailing Instructions
- 10. Scoring: See SI
- 11. Awards:
  - a. Fleets with 3 or more boats will receive First and Second Place trophies and awards.
- 12. **Disclaimer of Liability**: Competitors participate in the series at their own risk See RRS 3, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
