The **ECSC Racing Program** has a few open positions in their racing program for the upcoming 2025 racing season. These positions are for PRO racing assistants to assist experienced racing officers conduct and manage races and separately quartermaster positions for inventory and provisioning food and beverages for racers and crew to use self-serving their post-race meal on Wednesday night races.

There are **three open positions for PRO Assistants**. These are individuals that assist the Primary Racing Officer (PRO) in putting on races on Eagle Creek Reservoir on Saturdays, Sundays and Wednesdays throughout the sailing season. It requires no racing or sailing experience or knowledge. In fact, it is an excellent fit for those looking to learn more about sailing, racing or the ECSC sailing club. Your duties are to help the PRO start the races, sound horns, and record results. All your activity would be under the supervision and direction of an experienced and knowledgeable person that can and will direct, educate and supervise everyone. You will be **one of eight total PRO Assistants** sharing a schedule during the season.

Your work will be done while resting in a large, shaded pontoon boat that will be on the reservoir for a couple of hours. You will get to watch the race as it progresses and look at the beautiful boats and scenery of Eagle Creek Park. If you are an ECSC member you will receive **near full membership equivalent work credits** for your effort.

There are **two full quartermaster positions available** to those that would be interested in provisioning the refrigerator/freezer store of food that would be available for racers and crews to self-prepare their post Wednesday night race meal. This would not require one's presence at the Wednesday night race but the regular ability to visit the club to assess the inventory of food and beverage availability between races and the purchasing required to provision the stores for the upcoming race. Compensation for these positions would also be **near full membership work credit compensation** for members.

We are willing to **split** both the **PRO Assistant** and **Quartermaster positions** into half-time positions if this is more attractive to those interested.

Additionally, we would offer members only the ability to **earn 10 work credits** for being a **Regatta Sponsor** for one of our major regattas. These specifically would be the ECSC Regatta, the Indy 200 Regatta, the Hornback Regatta, or the Ladies Regatta. This would not require one to have any responsibility for running the races but would involve creating the social environment around the race, communications/advertisement to potential racers, establishing awards and trophies with the race programs support.
